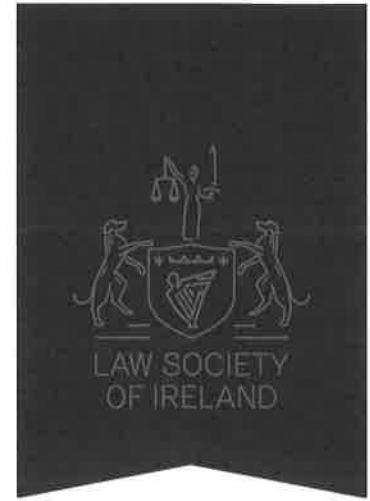

Re: Admission to the Roll of Solicitors

Dear Mr Grisales-Racini,

I am pleased to inform you that your name has been entered on the Roll of Solicitors in this jurisdiction on **Michaelmas Sitting, 21st November 2016**.

Your Solicitor Number is **S18612**.

It is important to note that newly admitted solicitors, who hold a Practising Certificate, are required to undertake CPD from the first day of their admission to the Roll. Upon admission, a newly admitted solicitor's requirement to undertake CPD is modified downwards in proportion to the number of weeks (out of 52) remaining in such CPD cycle. The application form to obtain a practising certificate for 2016 is available on the solicitors' area of the Law Society web-site. You can complete the form online prior to printing a copy for signing and returning to the Society with the full appropriate fee. This area is accessible by using your username and password. If you require assistance, please visit www.lawsociety.ie/help. In addition, you may request a form to be emailed to you by emailing: pc@lawsociety.ie.

Now that you have qualified as a solicitor you can become a member of the Law Society. You can purchase membership for the reduced fee of €20 during your first year in practice. Membership allows you access to a range of benefits and services. Some of the benefits that will be of particular interest to you as a young solicitor are Career Support, access to the Law Society Library, Gazette subscription, the Law Directory, and subsidised B&B at the Law Society.
